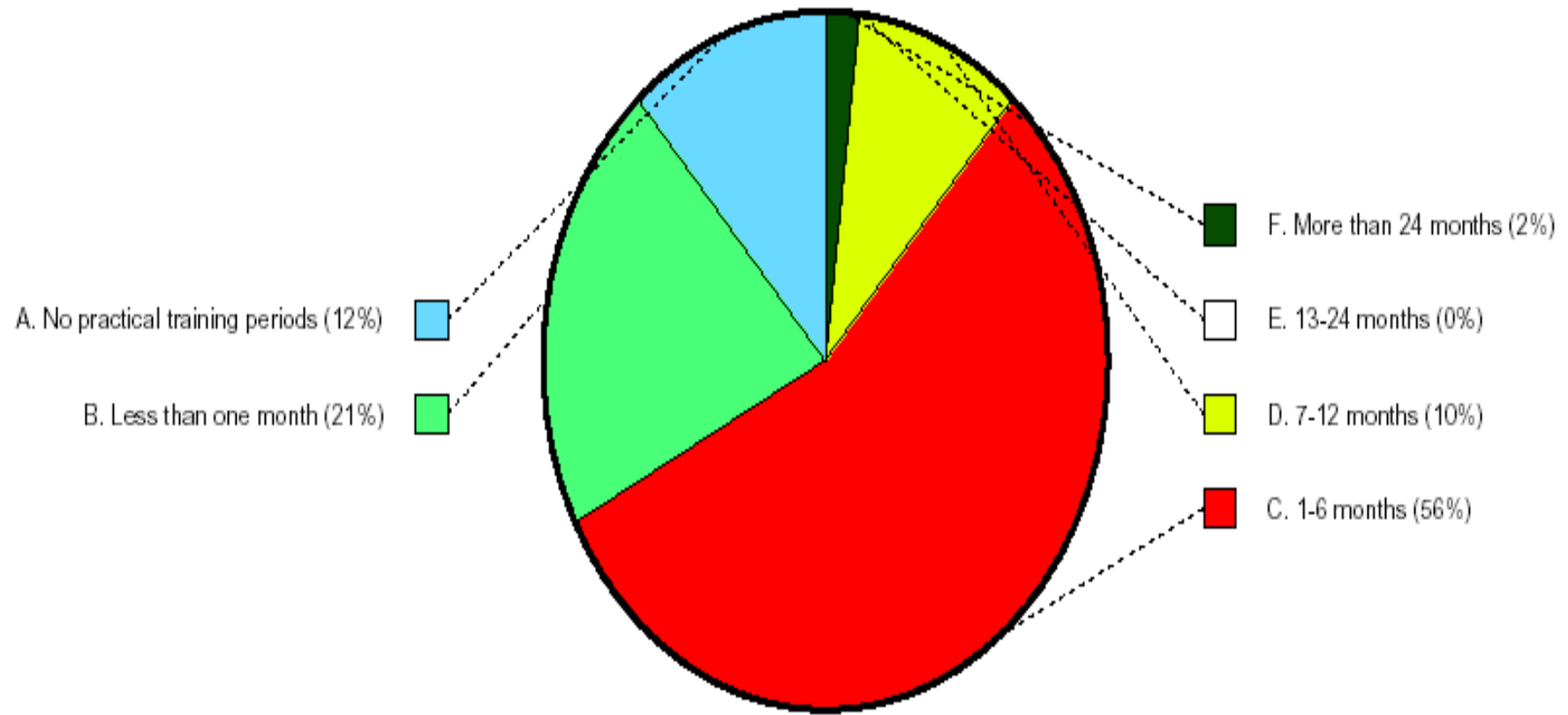

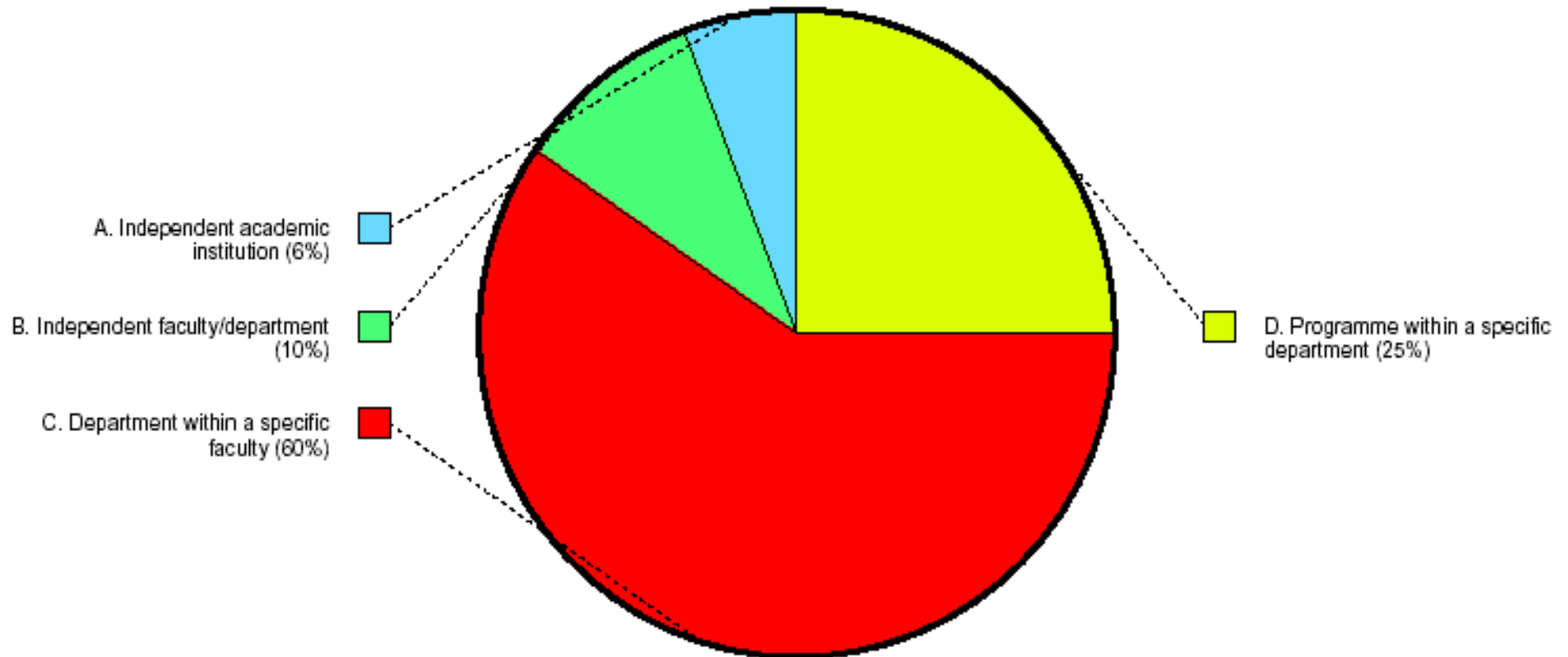

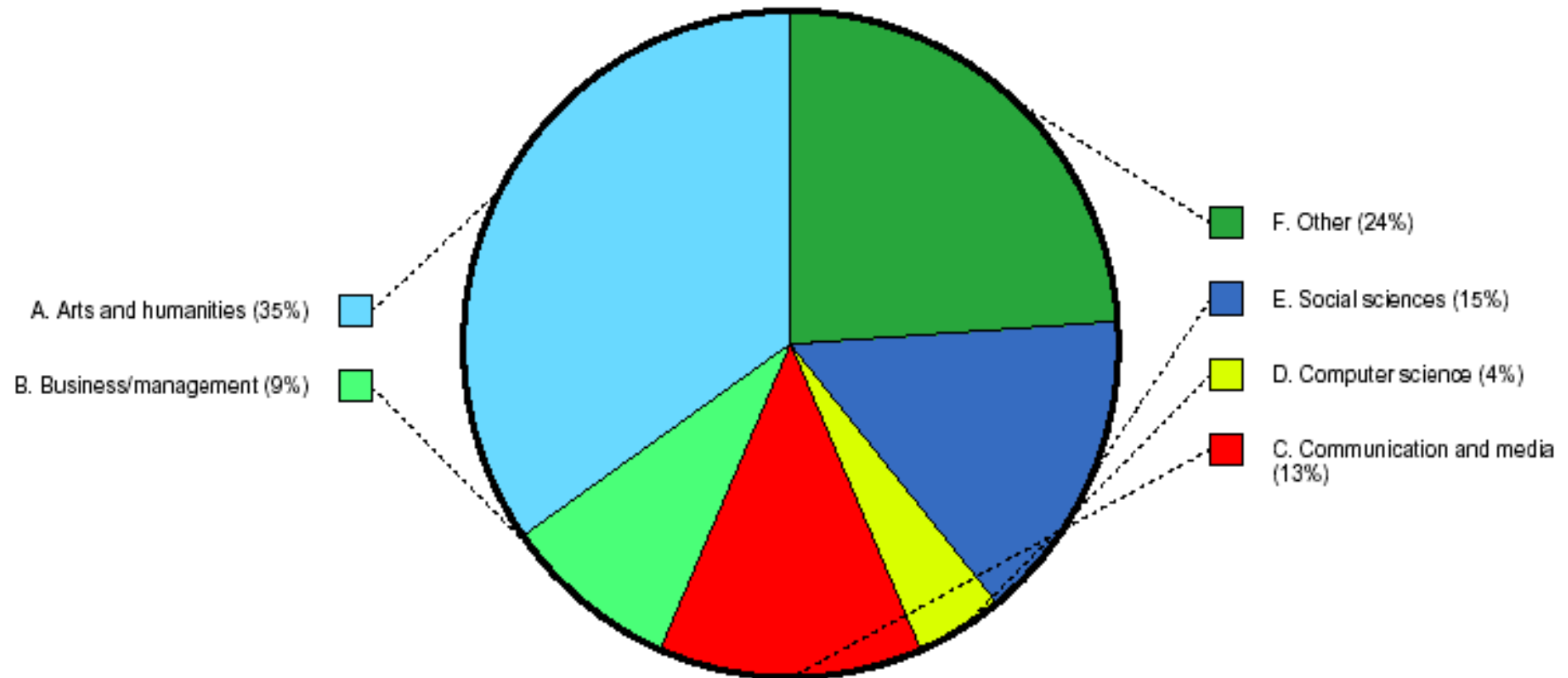
5. Entrance qualifications

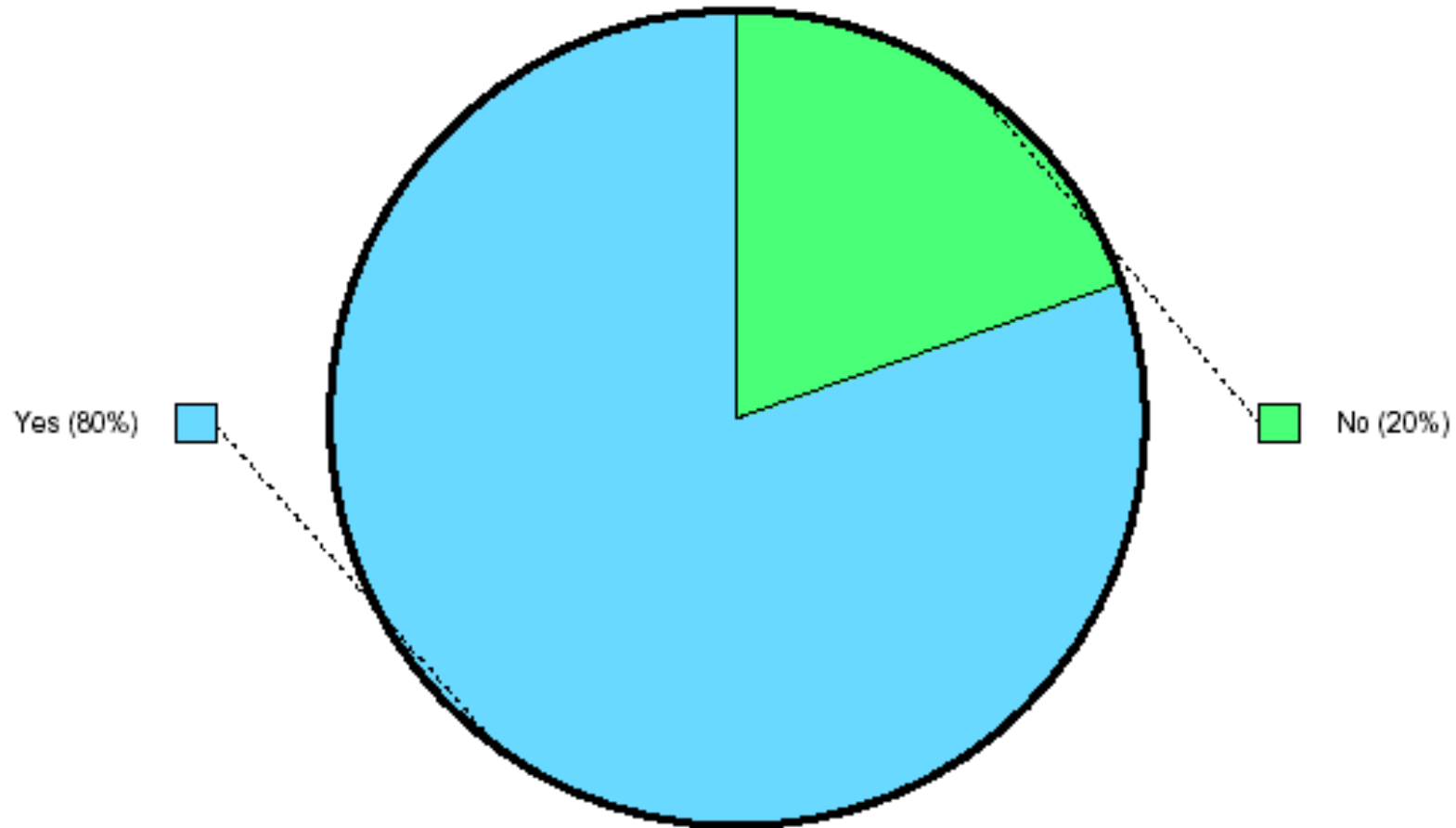
