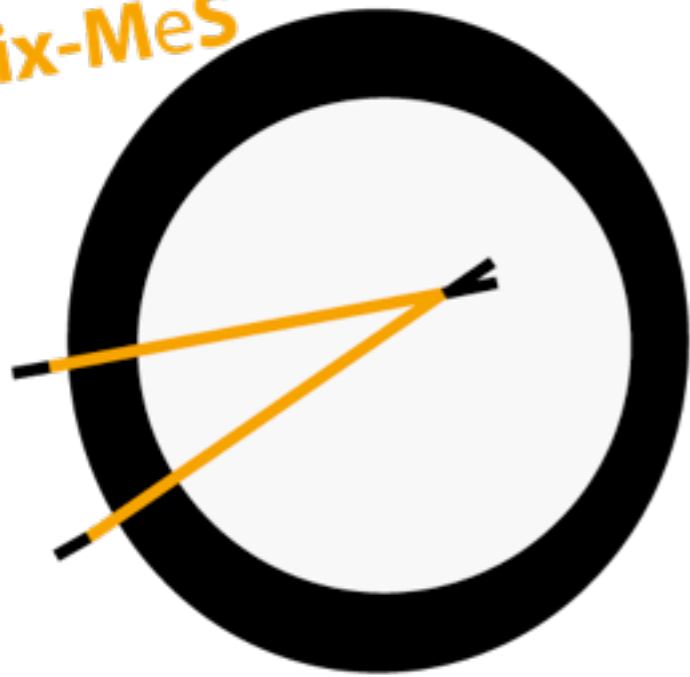

Unconference model

- **self-organizing**
- **free-flowing**
- **spontaneity**
- **exchange of ideas**
- **conversing face-to-face**
- **no positions, co-discovering**



Mix-MeS



uncourse course: mixMeS

- **online and face-to-face**
- **learning by doing (working on projects)**
- **find the best solutions by testing them in a real context**



steps

- 1. pilot project / experimentation:**
Department of foreign languages
Faculty of Humanities
(teachers and researchers)
- 2. communication**
during a Department meeting
- 3. short survey on needs**
- 4. online environment**
information, communication, exchange
- 5. brainstorming and project setting session**
- 6. working on projects**

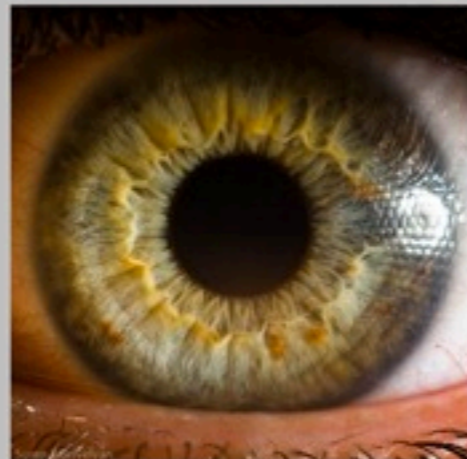

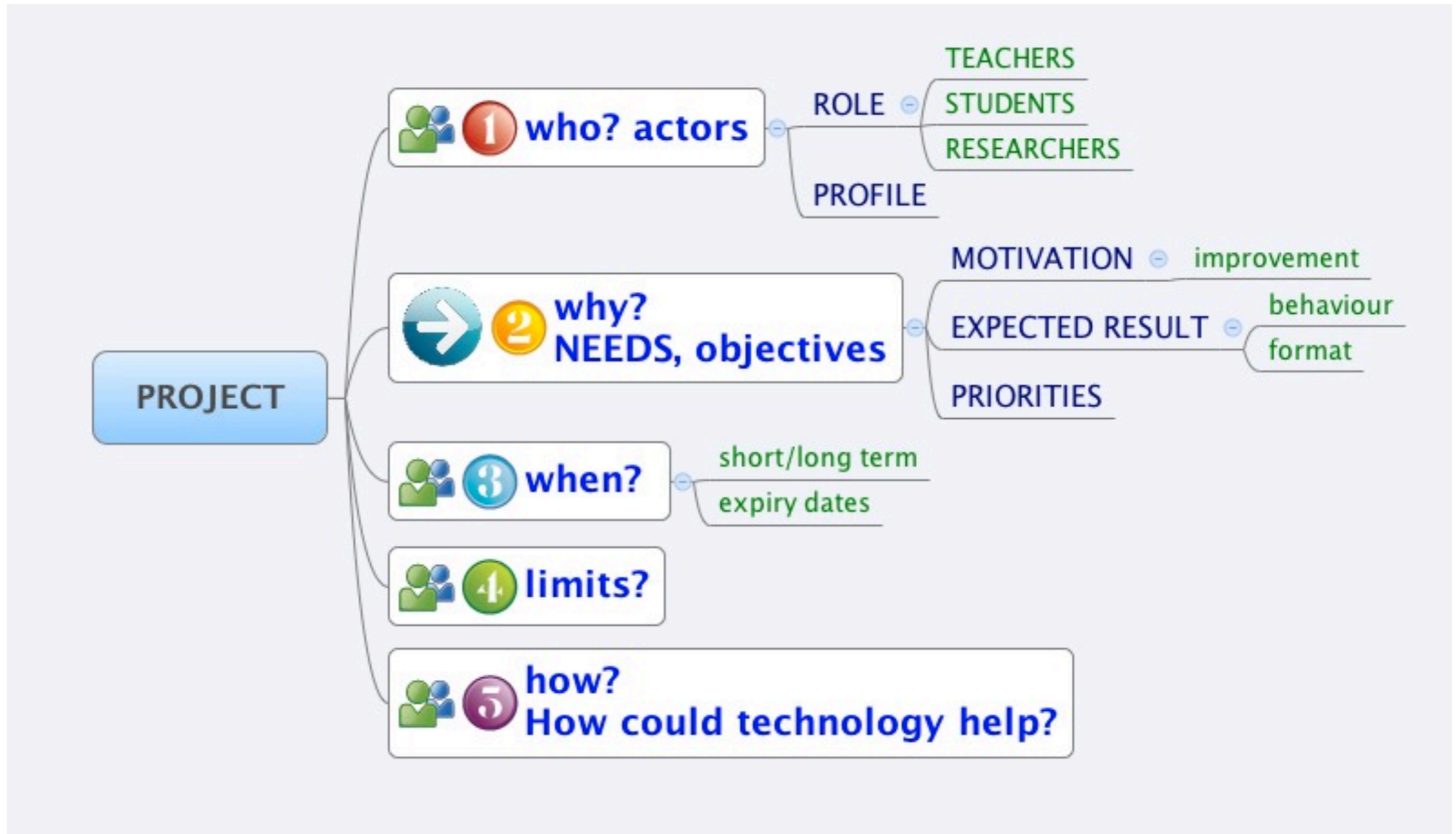

Critical issues and conclusions

(1/2)

- **DEFINITION of OBJECTIVES**
must be clear (and shared)
- **NEEDS: they will try and USE it**
IF they feel they NEED it
(and you will only know it IF you ARE there)
- **they will face IT if they perceive it is SIMPLE**
(and you have to keep it simple - “short pills”, just-in-time)



Critical issues and conclusions

(2/2)

- **communication should be improved:**
they have to understand what you can do for them and why their contribution is important
- **necessary to find a way to meet in groups (not one by one) to gather ideas**
- **research diaries**
- **e-collaboration: wikis, collaborative writing of experience reports**
- **consider CHANGE and EVOLUTION**
